- Whole sidewall exposed in open configuration (p5 lines 31-32; p7 Lines 16-17)	20

- Alter wording: shroud movably mounted wrt holder (p4 line 27)	4
Reduction for unnecessary limitations, e.g.:	
- Shroud is solid/ has no apertures;
