statistical comparison (Chi-square test) of pass rates for FD4 candidates in years 2014-2017 shows no significant difference (P>0.8) in pass rates between male ( $37.9 \%$ ) and female candidates ( $38.3 \%$ )
The relationship in numbers between the genders is broadly consistent: two thirds male, one third female
The percentage pass rate between the genders is broadly consistent such as in 2015 ( $1 \%$ in favour of females) 2016 ( $2 \%$ in favour of males) and 2017 ( $2.5 \%$ in favour of females)
In 2014 there was a $10 \%$ differential in the pass rate favour of males
