- (3) A PCT application was filed on 11th October 2010, claiming an earliest priority of 12th October 2009. The international search report was transmitted to the International Bureau on 19th November 2010. What is the last date for filing amendments to the claims under PCT Article 19, to be sure that they will be published? Give your reasons.

- (4) In the context of the Patent Cooperation Treaty, what do the following abbreviations stand for?

WO-ISA, IPRP, SISA, RO

(2 marks)

- (5) A PCT application was filed on 22nd May 2009 and claimed priority from a UK application which was filed on 23rd May 2008. What was the deadline for entering the PCT application into the European regional phase? Explain your answer.

(3 marks)

- (6) A European patent application was filed directly at the EPO on 15th September 2008 and was published without a search report on 12th March 2010. The search report was subsequently published on 1st July 2010. What is the deadline for paying the examination fee without requesting any extension of time? Explain your answer.

(4 marks)

- (7) A non-unity objection was raised on 5th May 2010 by the Search Division in a search report on a European patent application. The objection was repeated in a communication from the Examining Division dated 5th October 2010. When does the time limit for filing a mandatory divisional patent application expire? Explain your answer.

(8) What are the (minimum) requirements for obtaining a filing date for a European patent application?

(9) A first substantive communication from the Examining Division pursuant to Article 94(3) issues on a European patent application. It is dated 16th August 2011. Calculate the deadline for filing a voluntary divisional application.

(10) You have received a communication dated 19th October 2010 from the Examination Division, concerning a European patent application. The communication specifies a period of four months for filing a response. Excluding requests for extension of time, what is the final date for filing the response?

(11) What is the meaning of the following codes in relation to publication of a European patent application?

(12) A UK patent was applied for on 24th January 2005 claiming priority of a UK patent application filed on 26th January 2004. The patent was granted on 3rd November 2010. Giving your reasons:

a) What is the final date for paying the first renewal fee(s) on time? **(5 marks)**

b) What is the final date for paying the first renewal fee(s) with an extension of time but without an additional penalty fee? **(2 marks)**

c) How many years' renewal fees will be payable on those dates? **(2 marks)**

(13) The deadline for requesting substantive examination for a UK patent application was 30th December 2010. On 26th January 2011, you realised that you have not received the client's instructions, despite sending numerous reminders. What action must be taken to obtain an extension of time on this deadline? Give the new deadline.

(14) Due to an error in your office, the extended deadline in question 13 is missed. Can the deadline be further extended? If so, what action must be taken?

- iv) In the context of the above rights, explain what is meant by "registered" and "unregistered".
