#### **Question 1**

Renewal fees for designs are payable on the fifth anniversary of the filing day (the 1<sup>st</sup> renewal fee).

18 Aug 2010 + 5 years = 18 Aug 2015

They are payable on the last calendar day of the anniversary month. This would be 31 August 2015 (August Bank Holiday). This is a bank holiday so therefore it would be due 1<sup>st</sup> September 2015 (Tuesday)

b) If all renewal fees are paid, the design application would expire after 25 year from the filing date:

18 Aug 2010 +25 years = 18 Aug 2035

### MARKS AWARDED 3/4

Renewal fees for EP applications are paid whilst the application is pending.

The filing date = 28 January 2014.

They are paid on the 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the filing date.

28 January 2014 + 2 years = 28 January 2016.

They are paid on the last day of the calendar day of the filing anniversary month: 31 Jan 2016 (Sunday).

Therefore 1 February 2016 (Monday).
